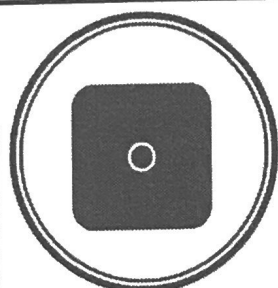
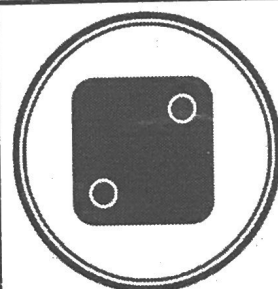


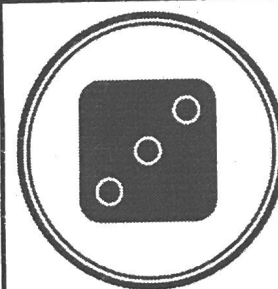
Informational Text RESPONSE



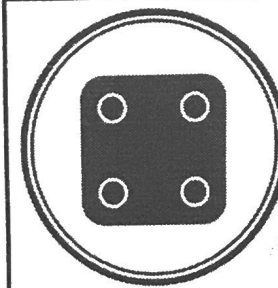

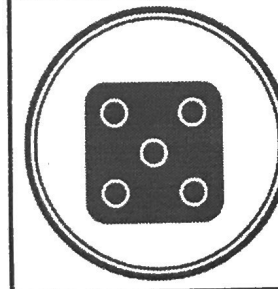
Favorite Facts: List 10 facts listed in the reading. Cite each one with a page number or described location in the passage. Order the facts from 10-1, 1 being your favorite. End with an explanation why the #1 fact was your favorite found in the reading. Make sure your list consists only of facts and not opinion.



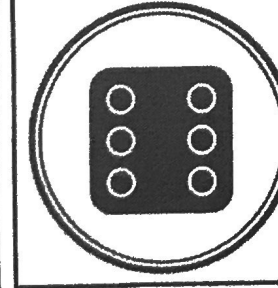
Text Feature...Feature: Recreate a chart, graph, diagram, or map from the reading. Then, explain it's relevance to the text and why you appreciated it. Another option would be to create a new chart, graph, diagram or map that displays information from the text. This text feature should assist the reader in better comprehending the information from the passage.



From the Editor: You are now the editor. Draft a letter to the author. State a connection you made to the piece, your opinion on the text. Explain what you liked, anything you disliked. Describe questions you still have, and make suggestions for content and text features that could be added to improve the quality of the piece. Set it up as a formal letter.



Illustrated Infographic: An infographic is a visual representation of information. It can be a combination of pictures, symbols, words, and facts. The goal of an infographic is for the viewer to quickly understand the most important ideas of after only looking at it for a few moments. Design an infographic that portrays the most important parts of the passage assigned.



Quiz Me: Create a quiz that includes one true or false question, one multiple choice question, one fill in the blank question, and one short answer question. Then create an answer key for your quiz. Each answer must be cited to the text. To cite the evidence of your answer simply provide the location of where it can be found in the passage assigned.
